## Event Description

The DDRSA is calling for a DDRSA Country Club to host the 2026 DDRSA Country Championships.

This event is to award the Age champions for the season for country swimmers and allow all swimmers to gain Qualifying time for Queensland State Sprints, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> February 2026.

DDRSA will place the meet on Swim Central and take all nominations. DDRSA will work with the host when creating the meet program to allow the host to add sponsors etc in the meet program. All nomination money will go directly to DDRSA, any event sponsorship will remain the host clubs income. Medals are provided by DDRSA.

DDRSA will supply the officials - Technical Director, Referee, JOS and Starter for this meet.

DDRSA is asking interested clubs to submit the following:

- What is the capacity of the host venue?
- What are the current restrictions that apply to the venue
- What are the Host club going to provide in way of Officials, Seating, and Catering available.
- What is the cost to DDRSA for this event. (Pool hire, cleaning fee, Lifeguard and any other costs)
- What is the major benefit to DDRSA for having the meet at your pool?
- What changes to the current program of events would the host club suggest?

## **Proposed Program**

### **The Venue**

Interested clubs are asked to please outline the Venue Capacity, along with changing facilities for disabled patrons, carparking details and restrictions that apply to the venue. Clubs are also encouraged to submit a seating plan and pool deck plan.

### **Equipment Needs**

Clubs are asked to submit the Equipment requirements for DDRSA, if any. DDRSA will supply the meet manager backup and will have computers if needed.

### **Risk Management**

Interested clubs are asked to please show how meet is going to have adequate Lifeguards and first aid in place for meet. Interested clubs are asked to outline Host clubs list of Meet positions i.e. meet director, First aid, Chief Timekeeper, AOE and any other positions deemed necessary by the host club. DDRSA will supply Technical Director, Referee/s, JOS and Starter.

The DDRSA is looking forward to working with the host club in the 2025-2026 season, and encourages clubs to tender for this meet. Tenders close 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2025.
